

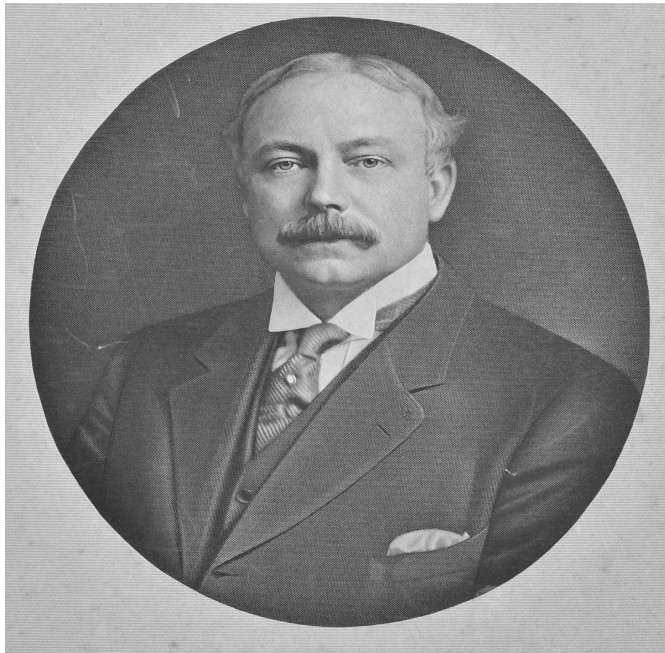

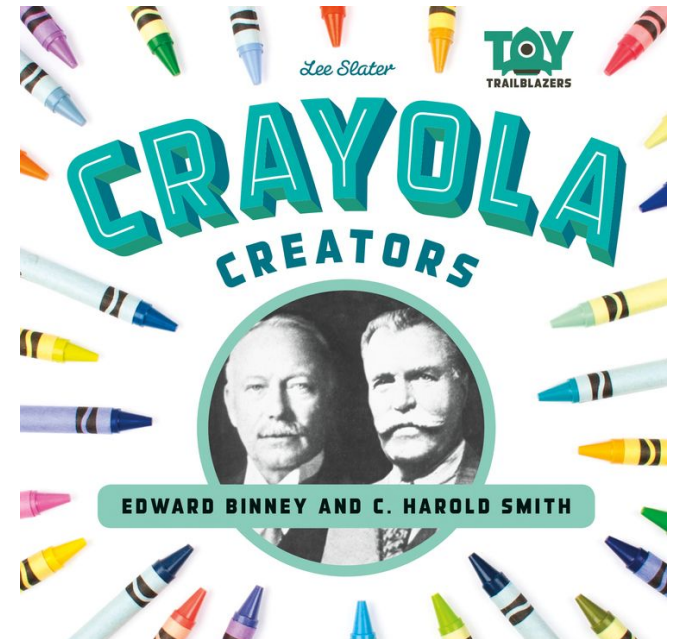
# WHERE IS HE FROM?

EDWIN BINNEY WAS BORN IN 1866, WESTCHESTER COUNTY, NEW YORK



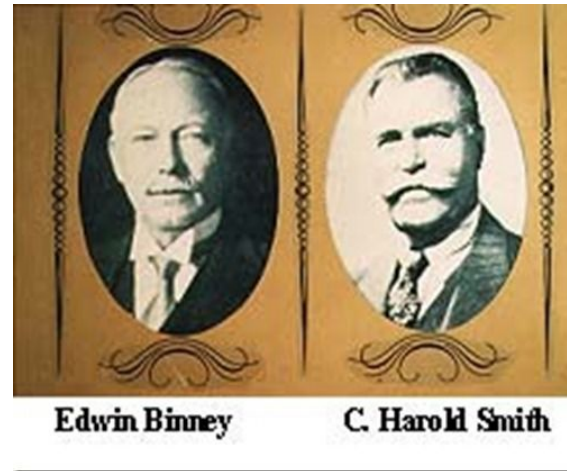
# WHAT IS HE FAMOUS FOR
